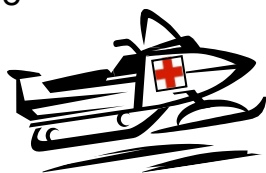

Where the Funds Go~

Low Costs:

An average of 91 cents of every dollar the Red Cross spends is invested in humanitarian services and programs. The Red Cross is not a government agency; it relies on donations of time, money, and blood to do its work.



Support for the

Red Cross - Chapter by Chapter: The balance of the funds each participant raises (after costs, minimal administrative fee and MSA's 5% have been deducted) will be returned to the Red Cross Chapter that serves the community chosen by that participant.

Support for MSA: The A.R.C. ride also benefits the Michigan Snowmobile Association with 5% of the net proceeds going to support MSA's work in the zero tolerance campaign, snowmobile safety and education, and in establishing permanent trails in Michigan.
